

## *Directions from Malaga Airport*

### **Getting out of the airport and round Malaga**

On leaving the airport, follow the road sign for 'Malaga' (not 'Torremolinos'/'Cadiz'). This means you will have to be in the outside lane after the roundabout shortly after exiting from the Airport. The 'San Miguel' brewery is on your right hand side. This will take you onto a section of carriageway which is the '**N340**'. Follow this road around until you get onto the m/way.



After about 2 km of carriageway you will see a sign for 'Motril'/'Antequera' which is a slip road to the right (see photograph right). Be careful here as it is very easy to take the wrong exit as the sign looks as if it is pointing to the 1<sup>st</sup> exit.

It is important at this stage to get into the inside lane (of 3) as the middle and outside lanes carry on into Malaga City Centre. This section of carriageway is signposted as the '**E15'/'A7**' (See photograph below).



This road is actually the ring road which will take you around the north of the city. You should follow the 'E15'/A7' signs all the way following the directions to 'Motril' and/or 'Almeria', see the picture to the right. It will take you about 20 minutes to travel up from the airport and round Malaga city. The road is normally clear however it can be slow in summer.



### Travelling from Malaga to Baviera Golf Course

Once you have left Malaga behind you continue on the motorway towards Almeria for about a further 20 minutes until you see a golf course on your right 'Baviera'. This is just past the town of Velez-Malaga. Immediately after passing 'Baviera', at the 276 Km marker, (see the picture on the right) you will see a sign for 'Algarrobo', which will take you off the 'E15'/A7' onto a slip road down to a roundabout.



At this roundabout, go to your left where you will see a signpost to 'Competa', (see picture on the right) which directs you under the motorway and straight to another roundabout. Follow the signs to Competa which direct you ahead and right onto the MA103. This road will take you through 2 villages called 'Algarrobo' and 'Sayalonga'. There are two new roundabouts in Algarrobo go straight over the 1st and be careful at the 2nd take first exit over the bridge there are no signposts here yet saying to Competa. Go straight through both villages and carry on up towards Competa don't worry this road only goes to 'Competa'. It will take 20, 30 minutes depending on how fast you travel to reach Competa.

## **Travelling Through Competa to Villa Andaluca**

Follow the road into Competa to where the road splits (Tourist Office on the right) take the road immediately right up the hill, carry on straight through the middle of Competa past a car park on your left until you reach a T junction (estate agents on the left and steep ramp to the right). Take the road to the left, after 100 yards road splits (do not take the road down ahead of you or the road which is sharply to the right, take the one in the middle that goes uphill). Follow the road up past the school (on the right) the road then bends left and goes past the Hotel Balcon and a little chapel. The roads then bends sharply right after 20 yds there is a sharp left turn signposted 'carril de circunvalacion' take this.

Then follow this road around and up until you see a 100 yard 6 foot high yellow wall on the right with Villa Andaluca in tiles at the far end, there is a sharp right turn at the end bringing you to 2 drives please take the lower one and park at the bottom.
